

#### Crimes of Violence (COV) – CR, § 14-101\* Violent Crimes (VC) – CS, § 7-101†

This table lists crimes of violence and violent crimes defined by CR, § 14-101 and CS, § 7-101, respectively, as both types of offenses are relevant to completing the sentencing guidelines worksheet:

- \* A worksheet shall be submitted for a reconsideration, modification, or three-judge panel review for a crime of violence, as defined in CR, § 14-101, if there is an adjustment to the defendant's active sentence (i.e., period of incarceration). COMAR 14.22.01.02 (9).
- <sup>†</sup> The court shall state in open court the minimum time the defendant must serve before becoming eligible for parole and mandatory supervision for violent crimes, as defined in CS, § 7-101. CP, § 6-217. The individual completing the sentencing guidelines worksheet shall indicate whether the court announced the mandatory serving of 50% of the sentence for violent crimes.
